Build a reading den. Find somewhere cosy, snuggle up and read your favourite book or listen to an adult reading to you.	Do something kind for someone. Can you pay them a compliment, make them something or help them with a task?	Find out about and make a poster of your family tree.	Keep moving! Make up a dance routine to your favourite song.	Interview a friend or family member who inspires you. You could write up, or film your interview.
Use an old sock to create a puppet. Can you put on a puppet show for someone?	Design and make a homemade board game and play it with your family.	Write a song or rap about your favourite subject.	Write a postcard to your teacher. Can you tell them what you like most about their class?	Make an Easter card to remind your family of God's love.
Thank a community hero. Think of someone that helps you in some way and write a short letter or a card to thank them.	Do something kind for someone. Can you pay them a compliment, make them something or help them with a task?	Get sketching! Find a photograph or picture of a person, place or object and sketch it.	Draw a view. Look out of your window and draw what you see.	Write or film a prayer on Easter Sunday to share with family members.
Can you create a story bag? Find a bag and collect items to go in it that relate to a well-known story. If you can't find an item, you could draw a picture to include.	Design your own coat of arms to illustrate your interests and values. Can you include a motto?	Draw a map of your local area and highlight interesting landmarks.	Collect a box of items which tell us about you or your family life.	Help with the cooking at home. Can you write down or draw the instructions for a family favourite recipe.
List making! Write a list of things that make you happy, things you're grateful for or things you are good at.	Design and make an obstacle course. How fast can you complete it?	Make an Easter bonnet with boxes and decorate with natural materials like leaves and flowers.	Draw a poster or happy picture to display in your window. It might make a neighbour smile.	Draw a family portrait.
